In-person Gatherings Guidelines

Last Updated: 8/6/2021

Groups may gather inperson with the following guidelines:

- Small groups recommended.
 Indoor meeting space must accomdate group size. Groups over 30 must seek pre-approval via the online ATA.
- Outdoors: Masks are optional.
 Indoors: Masks are highly recommended per CDC guidance.
- Keep three to six feet of distance between members of different households.
- Attendees should complete a prescreening form before each in-person activity and stay home when not feeling well.

Given the recent increase in COVID-19 cases and the highly transmissible Delta variant, GSCTX recommends following CDC and local guidelines to help prevent the spread of the disease. CDC guidelines suggest mask-wearing for all indoor, in-person activities. Social distancing is encouraged. Leaders should gauge participant comfort level when planning events and activities.
