- 7. Be sure to click SAVE in the bottom right corner.

In-person Gatherings Guidelines

Last Updated: 5/31/2022

Groups may gather inperson with the following guidelines:

- Groups Size No specific group size limit.
- Masks -Refer to CDC guidance for county community level.
- Physical Distancing

 Keep three to six
 feet of distance
 between members of different households.
- Pre-screening Prescreening forms are not required for volunteer-led activities. If you are not feeling well, stay home.
- APPROVED Girl Scout troop/group overnight travel is permitted. Volunteers are required to submit the online Activity and <u>Travel Application</u> for all overnight trips and day trips over 100 miles at least two weeks in advance.
